
Be a Silly Sketcher!





Chapter 2

Step 1

Start the eyes by drawing two large circles. Draw smaller circles inside the first ones. Then add **pupils** inside those circles.







Step 2

Add mouths inside each large circle. Add eyelashes too.

Step 3

Use straight lines to make arms and legs. Use dots for knees and hands.





Step 4

Make your eyes roll with roller skates.


Step 5

Use markers to outline your drawing. Then try colored pencils for shading it in.




Wandering Mind

Where does your mind go when it wanders?


Step 1

Start with two circles. Then draw a squiggly line in the shape of a brain.



Step 2

Use straight lines to make arms and legs. Use dots for knees.



Step 3

Add eyebrows and details to the eyes.



Step 4

Erase the **overlapping** lines inside the shapes.



Step 5

Add a mouth.

Add detail lines to your wandering mind.
